

Quilt Challenge Registration Form

SACKETS HARBOR QUILT SHOW

Show Dates: September 29, 30 and October 1, 2023

Welcome to the “For the Birds” Quilt Show Challenge sponsored by HAY MEMORIAL LIBRARY in Sackets Harbor, New York. This year we challenge quilters to create a quilt celebrating all things related to birds. Winners of the Challenge are awarded by popular vote with 1st, 2nd and 3rd and Honorable Mention cash prizes. First Place: \$100; 2nd Place: \$75; 3rd Place: \$50; Honorable Mention: \$25 gift card.

All entries must address the theme and meet these guidelines:

- **Style:** Pictorial, Appliqué, Embroidered, or Classic Patchwork Blocks – can be machine-stitched, hand-sewn, or a combination of machine and handwork.
- **Size:** No larger than 50” x 65” and no smaller than 24” x 24”.
All entries must have a 4” hanging sleeve stitched on the upper reverse side of the quilt.
- **Entry Fee:** \$10 per quilt, non-refundable.
Please make check payable to **Hay Memorial Library**, and note in memo line “For the Birds Challenge”

Description and labels: ALL QUILTS MUST BE CLEARLY LABELLED WITH OWNER’S NAME. Attach your label on the reverse side of the quilt. Please include the name of the quilt, the name of the individual who created the quilt, and a brief description of the inspiration for the work. If the quilt has “many hands” in the project, be sure to include the names of all persons in the quilt group. The show’s curators reserve the right to edit all text descriptions for length.

Entry Limit: Limit of three entries per person. Entries are accepted on a “first come, first serve” basis, but exhibit space is limited...register early! Quilts should be made within the last 18 months. Only the first 25 entries for the challenge will be accepted...no exceptions. All entries are numbered, inventoried, and dated upon receipt.

Letter of Interest: If you intend to enter a quilt, please send in your completed form with your entry fee. This will reserve your space at the show. Remember: There are only 25 available spaces, and it is first come, first serve.

Entry Date: All entries must be received at Hay Memorial Library by Tuesday, September 26, 2023.

Shipping and Handling: Quilts may be dropped off at the library during regular business hours between September 19 and September 26. Contact the library staff at 315.646.2228 to drop off your quilt in person.

Quilts are the shipping responsibility of the owner. If you ship your quilt, please insure your quilt and ship it to: **Hay Memorial Library, Post Box 288, 105 So. Broad St., Sackets Harbor, NY 13685.**

Return of quilts: Quilts may be picked up after 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, October 3 at the library, or by appointment during the week following the show. Pick up schedules will be posted on the website. If return shipping is needed, please be aware that **all shipping costs are the responsibility of the quilt owner, and can be arranged for in advance by enclosing a check to cover return shipping.**
